



How to get stop smoking medications covered by Medicaid:

Medicaid will pay for most stop smoking medications when you get a prescription or order from your health care provider.

▶ Get a prescription from your health care provider for:



Chantix, Nicotine Nasal Spray, Nicotine Inhaler, or Zyban.



For nicotine patches or gum you need a prescription order for "over-the-counter."

▶ How much can I get?

A supply of stop smoking medication twice a year. No more than a 90 day supply at a time.

▶ Ask your doctor about combining medications

Some stop smoking medications may be used together for better results. Ask your doctor and pharmacist about what would work for you.
